



## OMA reports 1.6o million passenger traffic in June 2021

**Mexico City, Mexico, July 5, 2021**—Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro Norte, S.A.B. de C.V., known as OMA (NASDAQ: OMAB; BMV: OMA), reports that terminal passenger traffic at its 13 airports increased 412.8% in June 2021, as compared to June 2020. Domestic traffic increased 370.9%, and international traffic increased 1,033.8%. It is important to mention that the base of comparison of June 2020 was still affected by the restriction of activities in Mexico.

Terminal passenger traffic decreased 21.0% in June 2021, as compared to June 2019. Domestic traffic decreased 23.6%, and international traffic decreased 0.5%.
