



OMA reports a 45.4% decrease in November 2020 passenger traffic

Mexico City, Mexico, December 4, 2020—Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro Norte, S.A.B. de C.V., known as OMA (NASDAQ: OMAB; BMV: OMA), reports that terminal passenger traffic at its 13 airports decreased 45.4% in November 2020, as compared to November 2019. Domestic traffic decreased 43.7%, and international traffic decreased 58.2%.
